The "SŁOWIANKI" ensemble is a representative artistic group of one of the universities, The Jagiellonian University in Cracow.

The ensemble was founded at the university in 1959 by Zdzisław WĄCZAK and an academic teacher.

Since 1972 the ensemble has been directed by Henryk WOLFF-ZDZIENIŁO.

Members of the group are mainly recruited from among the students of the Jagiellonian University and other academies and colleges in Cracow.

The repertoire of "SŁOWIANKI" comprises Polish national dances such as Mazurka, Oberek and Polonaise, as well as numerous dances and folk songs from the Lublin, Łowicz, Pieniny, Rzeszów and Silesia regions.

Years went by but "SŁOWIANKI" has remained faithful to the original intention to popularize songs, dances and tunes of Slavonic nations. The ensemble performs in original Polish, Bulgarian, Macedonian, Slovenian, Bosnian, Croatian, Serbian and Ukrainian folk costumes.

"SŁOWIANKI" has performed abroad on the number of occasions. So far in Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Cuba, Czech Republic, former Czechoslovakia and Slovakia), Denmark, Egypt, France, Germany, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, Libya, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, former Soviet Union, Lithuania, Russia and Ukraine), Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Tunisia, Turkey and former Yugoslavia (Bosnia - Herzegovina, Croatia, Macedonia, Serbia and Montenegro).

The ensemble represented Poland at many renowned international festivals such as Timgad (Algeria), Bonheiden, Charleroi, Edegem, Marchienne au Poiré and Torhout (Belgium), Cornwall and Drummondville (Canada), Zagreb (Croatia), Confolens, Dijon, Gannat, Le Puy, Plozevet and Port sur Saône (France), Lüneburg and Wismar (Germany), Billingham (Great Britain), Naoussa (Greece), Baja and Szekszard (Hungary), Haifa (Israel), Aviano, Camporgiano, Gorizia, Lignano Sabaudia, Tagliacozzo and Velletri (Italy), Nuoro and Quartu (Sardinia, Italy), Sicily, Italy), Scopie (Macedonia), Brunssum, Enschede and Odoorn (The Netherlands), Bratislava (Slovakia), Ljubljana (Slovenia), Barcelona, Ourense, Pamplona, Portugal and Viveiro (Spain), Soller (Majorca, Spain) and Ephesus (Turkey).

"SŁOWIANKI" took part in the Students' Cultural Festival in Paris and the Festival of Youth and Students in Havana as well.

The ensemble won first prizes at the festivals in Dijon (twice), Ephesus
